

Digital Millennium Copyright Act (“DMCA”) Notice

In operating the Services, Five Area may act as a “services provider” under the DMCA and offer services as an online provider of materials and links to third party websites. As a result, third party materials that are not owned or controlled by Five Area may be transmitted, stored, accessed or otherwise made available using the Service. You agree to notify Five Area if and to the extent any situation arises wherein you believe any material available through the Service infringes a copyright. Any claimant must notify Five Area using the notice procedure for claimed infringement under the DMCA and provide the following:

If you believe that your work has been copied and has been posted, stored or transmitted to Five Area’s website in a way that constitutes copyright infringement, please submit a notification pursuant to the DMCA by providing Five Area’s designated agent the following written information: (i) an electronic or physical signature of the person authorized to act on behalf of the owner of the copyright interest; (ii) a description of the copyrighted work that you claim has been infringed upon; (iii) a specific description of where the material that you claim is infringing is located on the website; (iv) your address, telephone number, and email address; (v) a statement by you that you have a good-faith belief that the disputed use is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law; and (vi) a statement by you, made under penalty of perjury, that the above information in your notice is accurate and that you are the copyright owner or authorized to act on the copyright owner’s behalf.

Five Area will respond expeditiously to remove or disable access to material Five Area determines may be infringing and will follow the procedures specified in the DMCA to resolve the claim between the notifying party and the alleged infringing party who provided the applicable content.

Neither this Agreement nor any interest herein of Customer may be assigned, sublet, or in any manner transferred by Customer without the prior, written consent of Five Area, which consent may be withheld in Five Area’s sole discretion. Any attempted assignment or transfer in contravention of the preceding sentence shall be void. A waiver by Five Area of any terms herein shall not be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach of this Agreement. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas without regard to choice of law principles. This agreement is accepted and performed at Rusk County, Texas, and venue shall be proper only in that county. No amendments or modifications to this Agreement shall be effective or binding against Five Area unless expressly agreed to in writing by an authorized representative of Five Area. In the event any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect under any applicable statute or rule of law, then such provisions shall be deemed inoperative to the extent that they are invalid, illegal or unenforceable, and the remainder of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect. Any invalid, illegal or unenforceable provisions shall be reformed and modified so that they express the original intent of the parties hereto as closely as reasonably practicable without being invalid, illegal or unenforceable.
