

What is FRS?

The FRS Youth Tour is an all-expenses-paid educational trip to Washington, D.C., designed to give high school students from rural communities a firsthand look at how our nation's government works. During the tour, students will:

- Visit famous historical landmarks such as the U.S. Capitol, the Lincoln Memorial, Arlington National Cemetery, and the Smithsonian Museums.
- Meet with members of the Congressional staff and learn how legislative and policy decisions impact their local communities.
- Explore career opportunities in communications, public service, and technology.
- Build friendships and connections with students from rural areas nationwide.

This trip offers a unique blend of education, leadership, and fun. Students come away with a deeper understanding of civic responsibility and the importance of staying connected to their communities.

Five Area Connect and the Foundation for Rural Service cover the following costs for the selected student:

- Round-trip flights and transportation to and from Washington, D.C.
- Hotel accommodations during the tour
- All meals throughout the trip
- Guided tours and event admissions
- Educational sessions and materials
- Supervision and chaperones provided by FRS

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must have completed their sophomore year of high school and be classified as a current junior or senior at the time of application.
- Applicants must have a parent or guardian who is a current Five Area Connect or Wesr Plains Communications customer.
- Applicants must be U.S. citizens, aged 15–17 at the time of the tour, and possess a valid ID.
- Applicants must be available to travel to Washington, D.C. during the scheduled tour dates in June 2026.
- A completed application and short-answer responses must be submitted by February 17th, 2026
